* The FireSmart Home Assessment Rebate provides compensation for fifty percent of the total value of the homeowner labour, hired contractor invoices, purchased materials, or any combination of the above. Homeowners' work on recommended mitigation is valued at \$32 per hour.

Minimum and maximum rebates are \$500 and \$4000 respectively: homeowner must itemize a total of \$1000 to \$8000 in work hours and/or purchases/invoices. Copies (scans or photos) of receipts and invoices are required to be submitted.

EMC staff may visit the property to confirm that eligible work was completed. All work must be completed before the rebate application is approved.
